Call to Order/Welcome

There were no nominations from the floor and no request for discussion. A motion to approve the slate was made and seconded. The Slate was voted in with 33 votes for approval and one abstention.

• Treasurer's Report

Treasurer Darlene Pierro gave the report. We started the month with \$966.76 in our Bank of America checking account. There was income from advertising revenue of \$500, \$600, and \$300, totaling \$1400, and a donation of \$100. So, our total income was \$1,500. The cost for printing the spring newsletter was \$1,245.50 and we had the recurring Mailchimp fee and the Bank of America maintenance fee, totaling \$41.50. So, our expenses totaled \$1,287.00. The beginning balance of \$966.76, plus total income of \$1,500, minus expenses of \$1,287 leaves \$1,179.76

Guest Speakers: Janet Gallant and Becky Batt from DontWiden270.org

The speakers updated the group about the current status of the State's project to widen I-270 and add toll lanes:

Initial plans to have Route I-270 widened by 4 lanes was announced in 2017. With the change of Maryland governors in 2022, it was expected that the plan would be dropped, however, it has not changed. It continues to be pursued. Some of the major concerns are for the environment, equity, and lack of a solution to the true traffic problems. On Monday, May 6th, the Rockville Mayor and Council voted to request the Maryland Department Of Transportation and the Transportation Planning Board to remove the lower I-270 plans. It is important to not let up and continue to voice the opposition to widening I-270. Organization Name Change

In order to help ensure that all neighborhood residents feel welcome without regard to their citizenship, and to bring WECA in line with the titles of most other Rockville neighborhood associations, the following proposal from the Executive Board to make a change to the name of the Association was presented to residents at this meeting:

"To ensure that the name of the Association expresses that all West End residents are valued and welcome, the charter will be amended to replace the word 'Citizen' with the word 'Civic', changing the Association's name to the **West End Civic Association**." A motion to approve this proposal was made, seconded, and was voted in by 37 votes in favor and one abstention.
